Come Prepared on Your Test Day

- Know exactly where your test site is located. Most third party sites are located on college campuses. Have a test site contact phone number handy in case you get lost.
- Bring only approved calculators. View a list of approved calculators at cwea.org/cbt under Calculator Policy.
- Bring a government issued photo identification (state ID or passport)
- Pack lightly. You will not be able to bring anything but an approved calculator in the testing room. Leave everything else in your car or at home.
