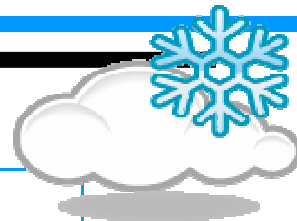
The California Water Environment Association (CWEA) is sponsoring two one-day specialty seminars entitled Global Climate Issues.
