Discussion of WEF sponsored Fats Roots Oil and Grease(FROG) project. Jeff Carter will draft letter regarding IAMPO revisions and send to CWEA members for comment.

TCP Program - Jeff Carter will be reviewing each exam series. Lab exams will be reviewed first based on need. CWEA funds will be expended for the review. Storm water certification will be reviewed by the

CWEA executive committee and they will validate the exam series. Storm water and Pretreatment will be combined Grade II and Grade III
