Our speaker will be Lani Good of HydroScience Engineers, a civil engineer specializing in collection system planning and design. Sanitary sewer overflows (SSO's) that occur in or near waterways pose risks to public health and have significant environmental impacts. Learn specific ways to approach emergency response planning for high-risk pipelines near waterways. Learn what special inspections to perform around waterways, when to conduct a risk assessment, what special considerations to include in your emergency response plans, and how to address environmental permitting.

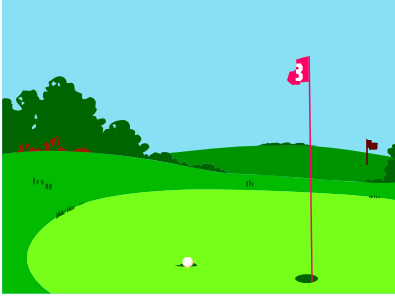
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2011 TOILET SEAT OPEN


