

As part of the [Waste Discharge Requirements](#), every collection system all publicly owned sanitary sewer collection systems in California with more than one mile of sewer pipe must develop a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP). The plan must include at least the eleven mandatory elements, and be approved by the collection system's governing body. The SSMP will be comprehensive, and so the WDR (plus a 6-month extension occasioned by the [memorandum of agreement](#) between CWEA and the SWRCB) has included a roll-out schedule for compliance based on population served.
