GREETINGS FROM THE PRESIDENT...

We made it through another winter! I welcome the warmer, dryer weather and longer days. This winter was too cold, at least for this California native.

The Bay Section had a busy month. The Collections System Committee kicked things off with a Hydrocleaning Best Practices training on March 5 at the City of Antioch. The training was a success and extremely popular, with 70 people in attendance and twice as many turned away due to space limitations (a reminder to sign up early to secure your space).

The Bay Section met for our monthly dinner meeting on March 6 at the Silver Dragon in Oakland. Julia Halsne of EBMUD discussed "Business Continuity Insights – Building a Resilient Agency." Julia has been working to prepare EBMUD to respond and recover from a major event, such as a large earthquake. The scope of the plan is quite mind-boggling, from maintaining chemical deliveries to coordinating with employees when the traditional communication facilities are unavailable to maintain the workforce (a real problem that affected New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina). Everyone would be well served to develop a similar plan.

The O&M Committee held a tour and lunch on March 19 at the Delta Diablo Sanitation District Wastewater Treatment Plant, drawing over 50 well-fed attendees.

As I'm writing this message, the PDC is preparing to hold a Biosolids Seminar on March 20 at Hs Lordships in Oakland. They were expecting over

40 attendees for which I anticipate was a well received event.

On behalf of the Bay Section, I want to extend my thanks to all of the Board and Committee volunteers as well as the staff at the City of Antioch, EBMUD, and Delta Diablo for providing these excellent training and networking opportunities for our members.

There's still time to sign up for the CWEA Annual Conference, April 13-16 in Sacramento. There's something for everyone, including workshops, tours, presentations, and the vendor exhibit. You can also check out the workshops and first demos for the computer-based certification tests (please note that the last paper-and-pencil test is scheduled for July 2008, and the first computer-based tests will be offered in January 2009).

I hope to see you at our next dinner meeting on April 3, which is our joint meeting with the Santa Clara Valley Section. See the flyer in this issue for additional details.

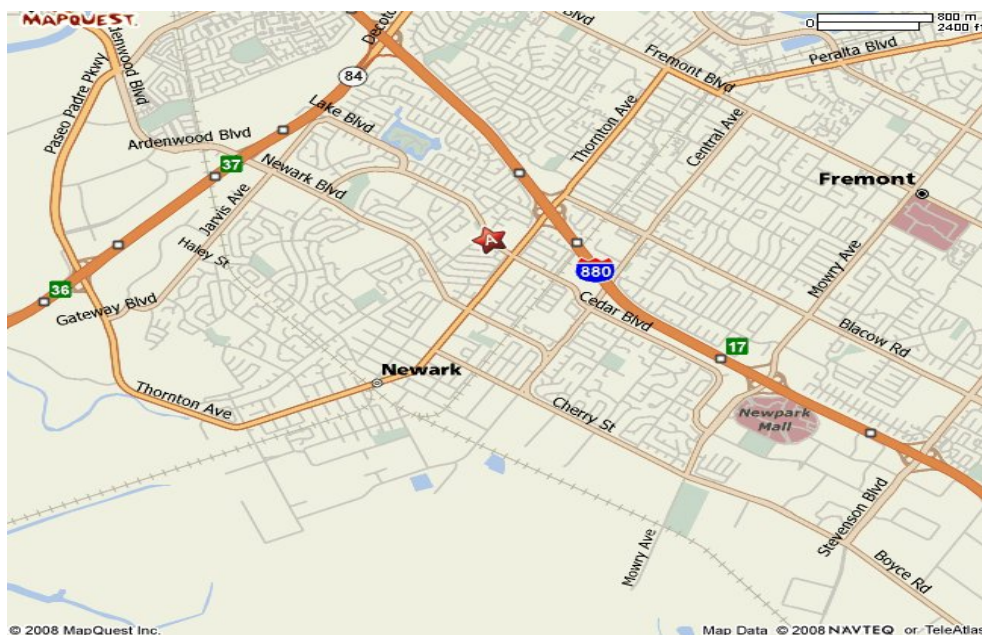

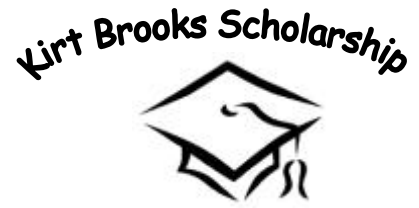

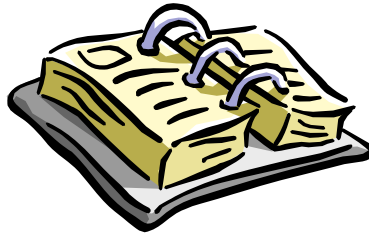
