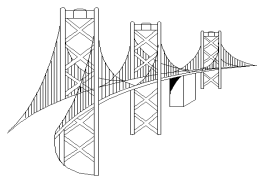

OK so check this out. It is no secrete that most agencies experience extensive I&I during rain. Shhhhh. Here at RSD we are no different. We have had some (well documented) SSOs from heavy rains. After some smoke testing last summer and a new CCTV inspection program we found a sewer line that ran parallel to a county storm drain and passed under a creek. This line was not in the best shape (as you could have guessed). As a result, we implemented an emergency project to replace this line before winter hit. We also redirected a portion of the line to eliminate a backyard manhole that had no access. We believe we hit a major Inflow source. The rains of February and March would normally have caused weather related SSOs for the District, but ALAS!! No SSOs!! This was very pleasing to see. We pipe-burst about 600 feet of line in this backyard easement and now have essentially a seamless line that is still parallel to the county storm drain. How do we know we were so successful? Well let's just say the residents down the hill along the storm drain path found out how much water our line was taking. Yes there was some minor flooding as the storm drain leaks (surprised?) and the creek had no where else to go. Now we are trying to work with the County (not easy) to get them to address this area.

From San Jose:

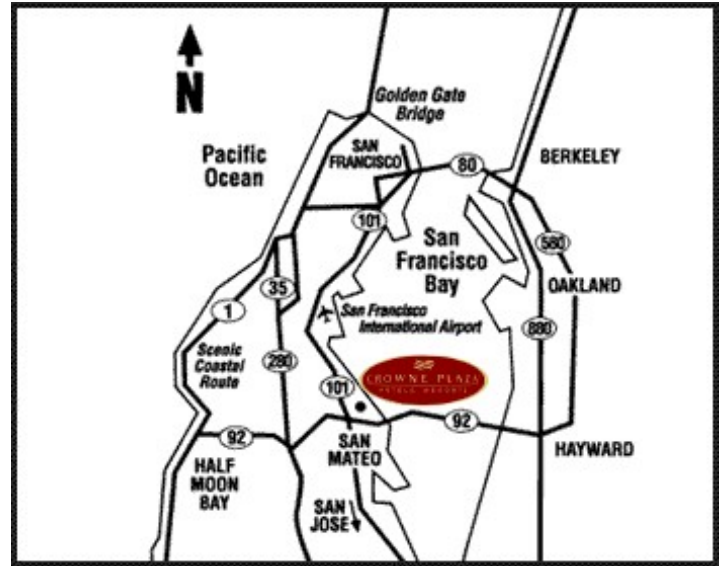
- Take 101 North or 280 North to Hwy 92 East (towards San Mateo Bride/Hayward)

- Turn left on Chess Drive

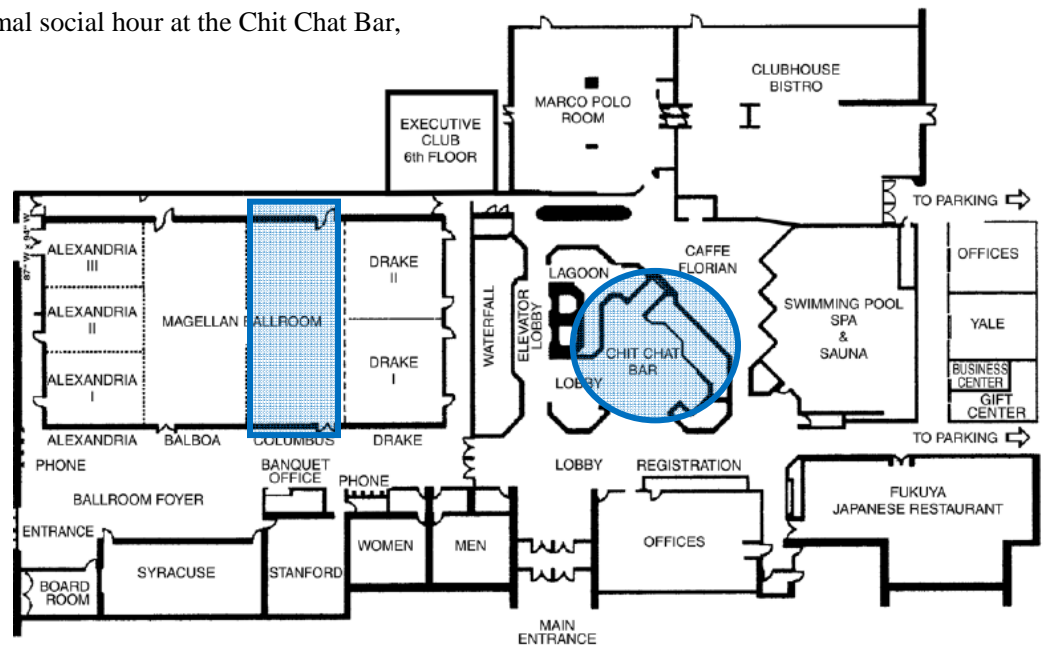


Social/Networking Hour

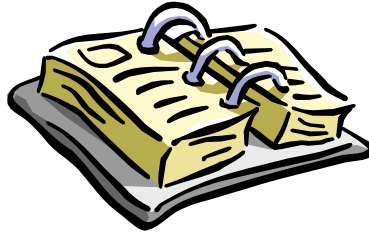
