Greetings!!

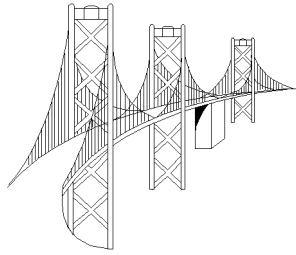

By Car:

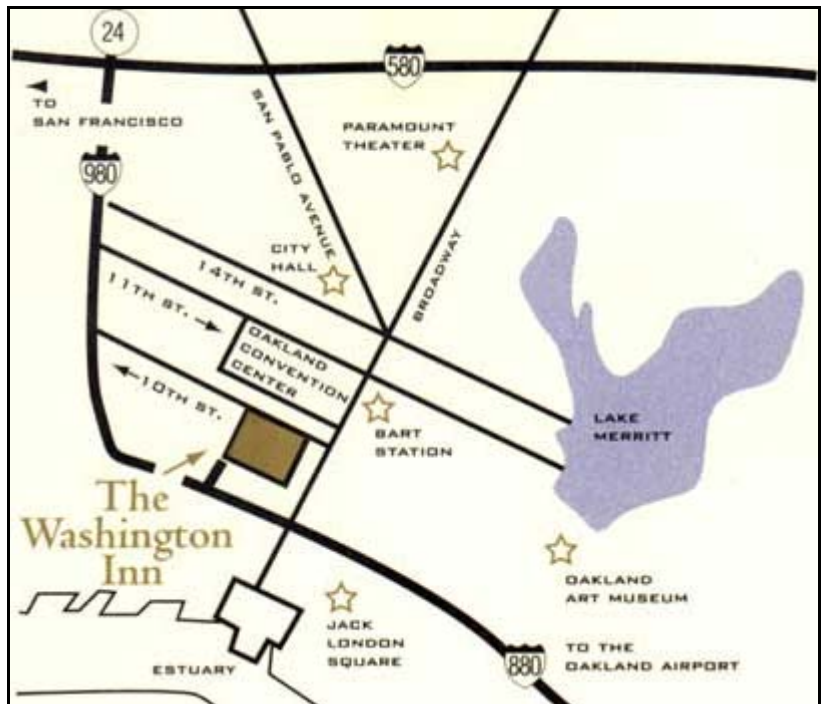
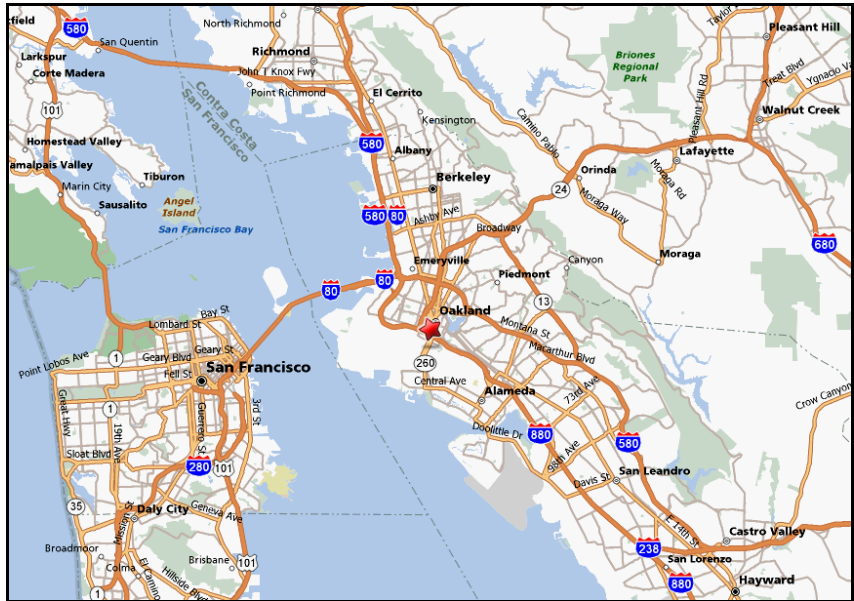
Street parking is available, but may be limited. Parking is also available at the Oakland Convention Center.

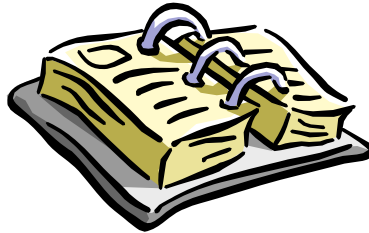
